PLANNING LEGISLATION AT THE CROSSROADS!

Friends of Ku-ring-gai Environment (FOKE) participated in a noisy Rally outside Parliament House Sydney at midday today, at the resumption of the NSW Parliament for 2014.

"We are waiting to see what Minister Hazzard will do with the Planning Bills which failed to be passed by the Upper House late last year" Kathy Cowley said

"Residents are calling on Minister Hazzard to take responsibility for the failure of his planning reforms and to go back to the Moore Dyer Report and start again" Kathy Cowley said

"Residents will continue fighting to ensure that the current NSW Planning Bills do not become law and that our planning system is reformed to hand back *"planning powers to local communities"* and protects our heritage and environment" Kathy Cowley said

FOKE and Better Planning Network's 440 affiliated groups remain determined to see the Planning Bills withdrawn.
